

Donation Policy

Fiction books, including hardbacks and paperbacks, with copyright dates 5 years old or newer, and in like-new condition; mass market paperbacks in like-new to very good condition with copyright dates no more than 10 years old will be accepted for donation;

Non-fiction and reference books with copyright dates 2 years old or newer, and in like-new condition; (certain non-fiction books may be accepted even if they don't meet the copyright criteria if the library Director deems them an appropriate addition to our collections) is accepted for donation;

We do not accept magazine donations;

AV materials, including DVDs, and CD's, 5 years old or newer are accepted; we are unable to accept VHS tapes or cassette tapes;

Office equipment such as computers and printers will be accepted providing they are less than 2 years old and are compatible with the library's computer network;

Historical items, with relevance to Brimfield, are always accepted;

All donations become the property of the Brimfield Public Library District and may be used, sold, or recycled at the discretion of the library Director. A receipt for donations is available, however, no value is given to the donation; only a description of what is being donated.
