#### **Biographical Information and Summary of Interview:**

Harriett (Murdoch) Blundy was interviewed by Henrietta Memler on 29 Nov 1986 for the Brimfield Historical Society. It was recorded on cassette tape. In April 2022, Kim (Claybaugh) Hanks converted the cassette to a digital recording.
